ILLNESS AND ABSENCE - (Please see new attendance rules further down in Newsletter)

If your child is absent from school due to illness of any type, it is important that you contact school before 9am.

Important new attendance rules

Every School Day Matters!

5 consecutive days of term time leave

Penalty Notice Fines will be issued for term time leave of 5 or more consecutive days.

10 sessions of unauthorised absence in a 10 week period

Per parent, per child

Penalty Notice Fines will issues to each parent. For Example 3 children in school, each parent would receive 3 separate fines.

First Offence

The first Penalty Notice is issued for term time leave or irregular attendance the amount will be £160 per parent per child paid within 28 days.

Second Offence (within 3 years)

The second time a penalty notice is issued for term time leave or irregular attendance the amount will be £160 per parent, per child to be paid within 28 days.

Third Offence and Any Further Offences (within 3 years)

The third time an offence is committed for term time leave or irregular attendance a penalty notice will NOT be issued and the case will be taken to Magistrates' Court. Fines can be up to £2500 per parent per child. Cases found guilty can show on your DBS as "failure to safeguard a child's education".
